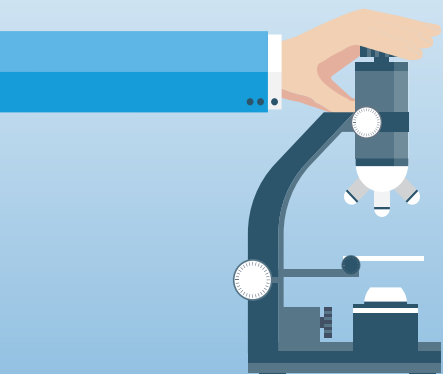
Supporting healthcare as the UK leaves the EU

What does the Brexit Health Alliance want? Our 5 asks

We aim to make sure that patients and the healthcare sector that supports them, are in the strongest possible position once the UK leaves the EU.

Research

Maximum levels of research and innovation collaboration with the EU so UK organisations and the public can take part in EU networks and trials.



Regulations

Alignment with the EU on the regulation of medicine and medical devices in the interest of patient safety and care.



Reciprocal healthcare arrangements

Preservation of healthcare arrangements for UK nationals in the EU, and EU citizens in the UK.



Public health and disease prevention

Strong coordination between the UK and the EU in dealing with pandemics and the promotion of disease prevention.



Funding

A strong commitment to funding the health and public health sectors, ensuring that any shortfall is offset.
