



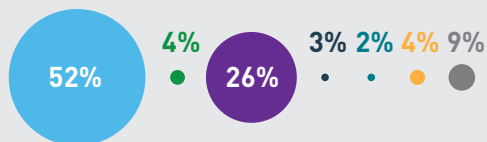

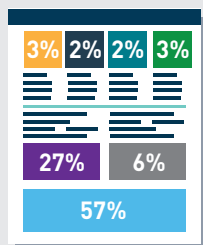

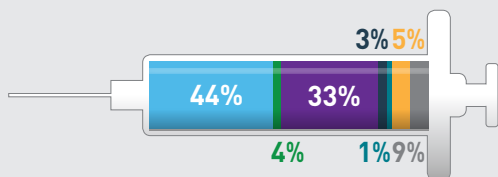
### All medical and dental staff<sup>2</sup>



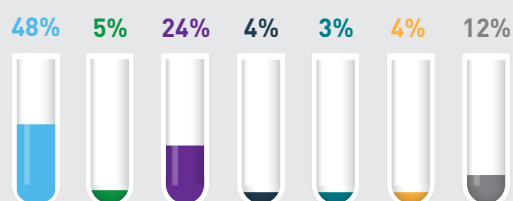
### Consultants<sup>2</sup>



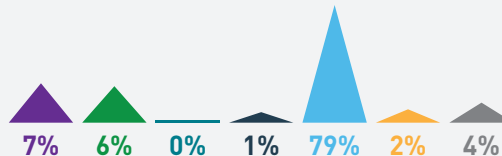
### Other medical and dental staff<sup>2</sup>



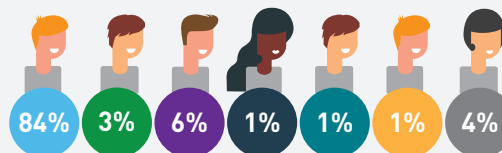
### Doctors in training<sup>2</sup>



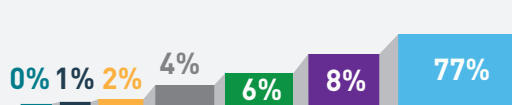

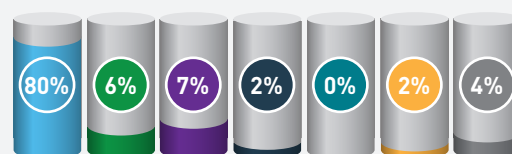
